<p>1 Are the claims backed up with supporting evidence?</p> <p>X There is no study referenced or very little data is given</p> <p>✓ There is a detailed study referenced that tested a large amount of samples over a long period of time over a large area</p>	<p>2 Who published the evidence?</p> <p>X An individual with no qualification or it is unclear who is making the claim</p> <p>✓ A qualified professional in this area</p>	<p>3 When was the evidence published?</p> <p>X Long ago (over 20 years)</p> <p>✓ Recent date</p>
<p>4 Where was the evidence published?</p> <p>X On a website or on social media channel that has a poor reputation</p> <p>✓ In an academic study or a reputable publication</p>	<p>5 Is biased language used? Is the language used precise and accurate?</p> <p>X Words and phrases that show a preference towards something and are used to highlight a point of view</p> <p>✓ More than one viewpoint has been considered with supporting evidence</p>	<p>6 Does the evidence have any visual signs or symbols?</p> <p>X Unrecognisable logos are used or no logos are present</p> <p>✓ Recognisable logos are used</p>
